The rejected have a purpose: Your Maker uses the weak to shame the strong. He is all powerful, all wise, and sovereign yet when you read the Bible you see that He uses the rejects, the weak, the beat down to carry His messages.

The world celebrates the wise, the valiant, the mighty, the high and the loved, however your Maker doesn't, He uses rejects and outcasts to accomplish His divine plans. David was rejected by his own father, but he wasn't rejected by his heavenly Father.

When you have been forgotten by men and not invited to the table, your Maker remembers that. The heavenly Father we serve elevated those who are made low by society, and our next outcast is a demonstration that He will allow negative things to happen to His son's followers so that His purpose can be manifested in their lives.

Joseph had a few bouts of rejection. He was sold by his brothers, lied on by Potiphar's wife and placed in prison. Sometimes people are trusted by the heavenly Father to undergo hardships so that His good can work for others. He must've looked at Joseph's heart and seen the humility necessary to accomplish His purpose. Your Maker is keenly examining the posture of hearts. Joseph had the posture in his heart not only when he was rejected by man but when he was promoted by the heavenly Father.

Moses was a misfit Prince who rejected the blessings of the house of Pharaoh. Moses's people rejected him. Moses had stutter and could hardly speak yet the heavenly Father chose him to negotiate with kings.

The majority of Christ's followers have been rejected by man, the heavenly Father creates them to be different, He has set them apart, and He has this wonderful way of using misfits. So if you never seem to "fit in" anywhere let me remind you that "not fitting in" is a normal part of life for many good people in the Bible. Rejection is a normal experience for people that your heavenly Father has chosen.

Christ is the chief example of this. He was beaten, mocked, and people cheered at his crucifixion, but be comforted by the knowledge that your Maker has exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name above all names.

Those who are considered rejects, misfits, black sheep, scapegoats, outcasts, conspiracy theorists and truthers have an assurance from the witness of the Bible that the heavenly Father has a use for those who follow His son. Those that do are chosen in the savior Christ before the foundation of the Earth.

Don't forget your Maker is pouring out His Spirit onto all of those with the eyes to see and the ears to hear, and He has chosen them for the noblest of all callings.

There is no higher place to be than under the anointing of the heavenly Father, there is nothing more valuable than being considered of worth to Him, and there is no greater promotion than to be in the place where the heavenly Father is.
